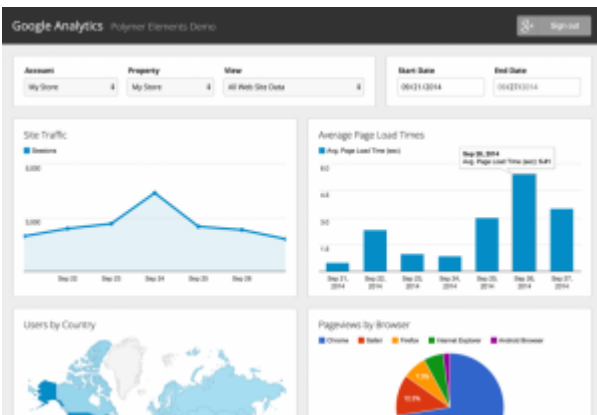


# What to Test - Website Usability Testing Guide
